Hard Waste Service Conditions

Items suitable for hard waste collection:

Household Furniture

Chairs, couches, beds, mattresses, carpets (must be rolled and tied)

Household Appliances

Refrigerators, stoves, washing machines, dishwashers, domestic hot water systems, small kitchen appliances

Domestic Household Items

Eg. Toys, bikes, old tins, empty clean paint tins (with lids removed), scrap iron, car rims (not tyres)

and other waste metals

Electronics

Computers, TVs, power tools

Cardboard and paper bundled

Plastic

(clean with no other materials attached)

Concrete, clay bricks, other masonry

Items NOT suitable for hard waste

Green waste

Domestic mobile bin waste

Garbage bins

Hazardous waste

Car bodies/car parts or large scrap steel

Rock, dirt

Ammunition or explosives

Gas bottles

Paint tins containing paint

The items to be disposed of must have resulted from fund raising activities for recognized charities.

The non-profit organisation must be based within the City of Salisbury.

The number of trailer loads of 'hard waste' permissible in any one financial year will be six and not more than 2 loads per quarter. Trailer load to not exceed 2.1m x 1.5m (7'x5'x5'high)
