

Verge maintenance



The City of Salisbury operates a verge maintenance program to help keep our City clean and tidy.

Verge maintenance cycles occur:



every five to seven weeks



Monday to Saturday



6am to 7pm

Verge maintenance includes:

Litter removal

- Litter is cleared from verges before any maintenance begins.

Tree debris removal

- Excess tree debris are removed ahead of mowing.

Mowing and edging

- Verges are mowed and mechanically edged to prevent grass from encroaching on nearby structures.

Weed control

- Targeted treatment is applied to broadleaf weeds and declared pest plants.

Grass cutting

- Grass is cut evenly to a height of 50mm; clippings are left on the verge.

Cleaning

- Paths and driveways are cleared of debris using blowers after mowing and edging.

Street sweeping

- Streets are swept within 24 to 48 hours following verge maintenance.
