Burton Communal Garden

Seniors Program



The Burton Communal Garden is a shared garden space for people to experience and learn about food gardening at home and the related skills. Also for people to enjoy a green space.

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday a Social Participation & Diversity team (who works with older adults in Salisbury) staff member runs a variety of programs and activities in the garden. These aim to be a way to involve people in interesting projects and events around the theme of gardening, and for it to be beneficial to both the body and mind.

A small group of volunteers assist in the garden and we invite seniors of Salisbury to join us in this new shared garden adventure, to make it a great space for many to enjoy. Please turn over to see the arrangements (requirements) for those Over 50's looking to attend our Burton Communal Garden programs regularly.

Adults of any age are able to attend our 'Workshop Wednesday program' (bookings required), which are education sessions on particular topics as a one off (including Guest Speakers) or short gardening courses over a couple of consecutive weeks. Additionally, the Burton Community Hub will additional gardening offerings from time to time open to the general public on other days of the week.

Being a new gardening program the groups and opportunities we will have available will be extended over time.

Gardening Group Tuesdays, Wednesday, Thursday 9am-12pm

This Over 50's group is actively in the garden doing a variety of task to keep the garden flourishing. Activities include sowing and planting out garden beds, building new structures for the garden beds e.g. trellising and shade frames and other gardening based building projects.

What is required to be a regular participant at the Burton Communal Garden?

Adults over 50 are welcome to attend any of our program offerings. If you intend coming regularly to a particular group or a variety of groups, we require (ask) you to become a member of our Over 50's centres.

The cost of this for the 2022/23 Financial year is \$12 and gives you access to attend any of our groups, activities & special events at our other over 50's centres (Jack Young Centre - Salisbury; Para Hills Senior Centre; Pine Lakes centre) There are all types of programs, events & activities available & also delicious lunches / take-away meals.
