

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Art work is entered at your own risk.
- Artist under 18, will need to seek permission from their parent/guardian before submitting an entry.
- Four artworks maximum per entrant is permitted and must be the original work of the entrant and any works that infringe copyright may be disqualified.
- Entrants must be aged 12 to 30 years (at the time of closing date).
- The City of Salisbury reserves the right not to accept any entry it deems unsuitable or offensive.
- Note: artworks are not to be offered for sale within the time of submission until the completion of the exhibition, and the City of Salisbury will not engage as an agent for the purpose of selling the works on the entrants' behalf.
- Online entries close at 5pm on Monday 25 July 2022.
- People's Choice, public vote via online gallery <https://padlet.com/Twelve25/SALA2022> of \$100 voucher to be won. The voucher is to be collected from Twelve25 Salisbury Youth Enterprise Centre, 17 Wiltshire Street Salisbury.
- Voting closes on 30th August at 4pm with the winner to be contacted and announced on the YouthinSalisbury Facebook page on 31 August to close SALA. Entrants are encouraged to invite family and friends to visit the online gallery to vote.
- The artworks and their photographic reproductions may be used to develop promotional materials for this event and future Youth Activities. The artist accepts that the work may be reproduced, in whole or in part, for promotional purposes by the City of Salisbury. The artist will be acknowledged by name and prize won wherever the work is reproduced.
