

Acceptable evidence when providing ID to Obtain your Learner's Permit

Students must provide **Three (3) pieces of evidence** in total. Each piece must provide evidence of their Birth, Signature **and** Current Address. **You can only provide evidence once, from any one agency.**

MUST HAVE THESE DOCUMENTS ON THE DAY OF TESTING

i.e. You cannot use Centrelink as evidence for Proof of address and signature. It can only be accepted as one or the other.

1 PROOF OF BIRTH (EVIDENCE of CHANGE of NAME)

- Birth Certificate (commemorative certificates are not valid)
- Passport (can be up to 2 years out of date)
- Proof of Age Card

2 PROOF OF SIGNATURE

- Centre Link Card (Pension)
- Health Care Card
- Student ID (must have signature on it)
- Bank Card (must have signature on it)

3 PROOF OF CURRENT ADDRESS

- Centre Link Card (Current)
- Health Care Card (Current)
- Bank Statement (No more than one year old)
- Electricity Bill (No more than one year old)
- ATO letter (No more than one year old)

ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ORIGINALS ONLY
