This project forms part of the City of Salisbury's City Plan 2035, aligning with the Salisbury City Centre Renewal Strategy.

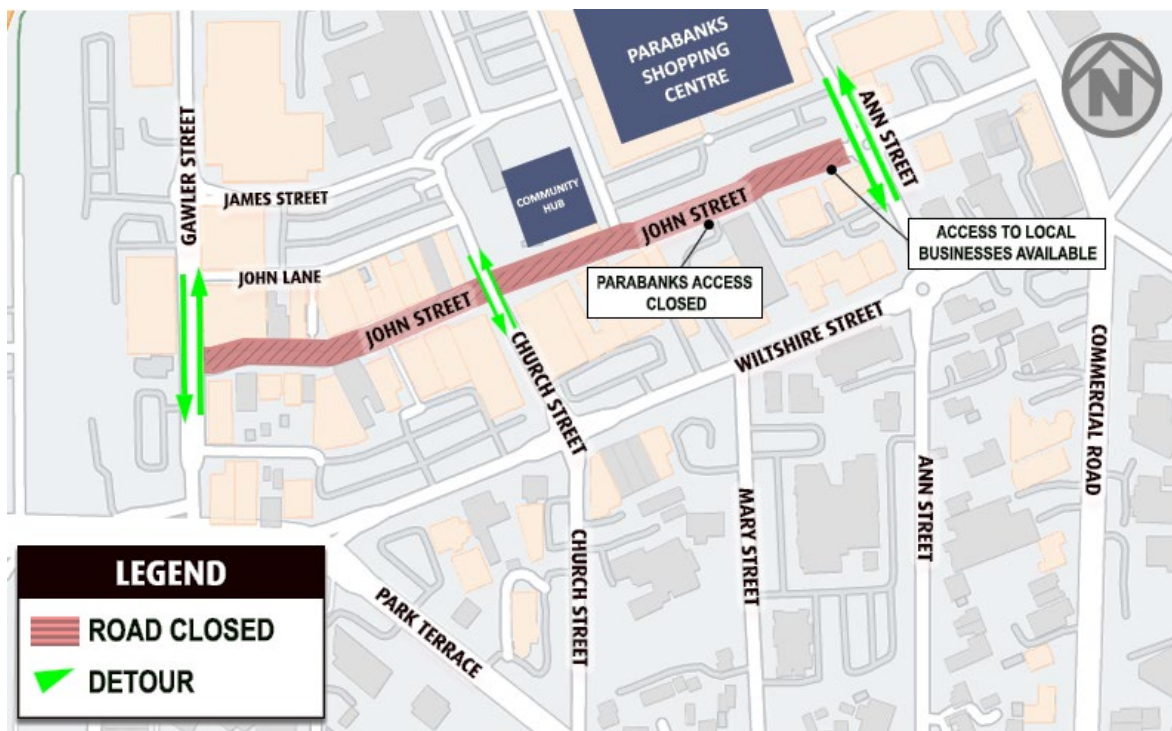
### Upcoming road closures

To facilitate the roll out of the Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project's Smart City infrastructure, the following road closures are required to accommodate light pole installation works.

John Street (Gawler Street to Ann Street)

**Tuesday 29 November to Friday 2 December 2022 - Closed Daily - 5.30am until 9.30am (Mornings only)**

**Monday 5 December to Friday 9 December 2022- Closed Daily - 5.30am until 9.30am (Mornings only)**

### What to expect

Temporary detours will be in place for each road closure. Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restrictions to pedestrian and cyclist access with signage in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
