The \$8 million Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project is funded by the City of Salisbury with part funding from the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and will see the continued renewal of the City Centre, creating a sense of place which reflects Salisbury's heart and identity.

Upcoming road closure

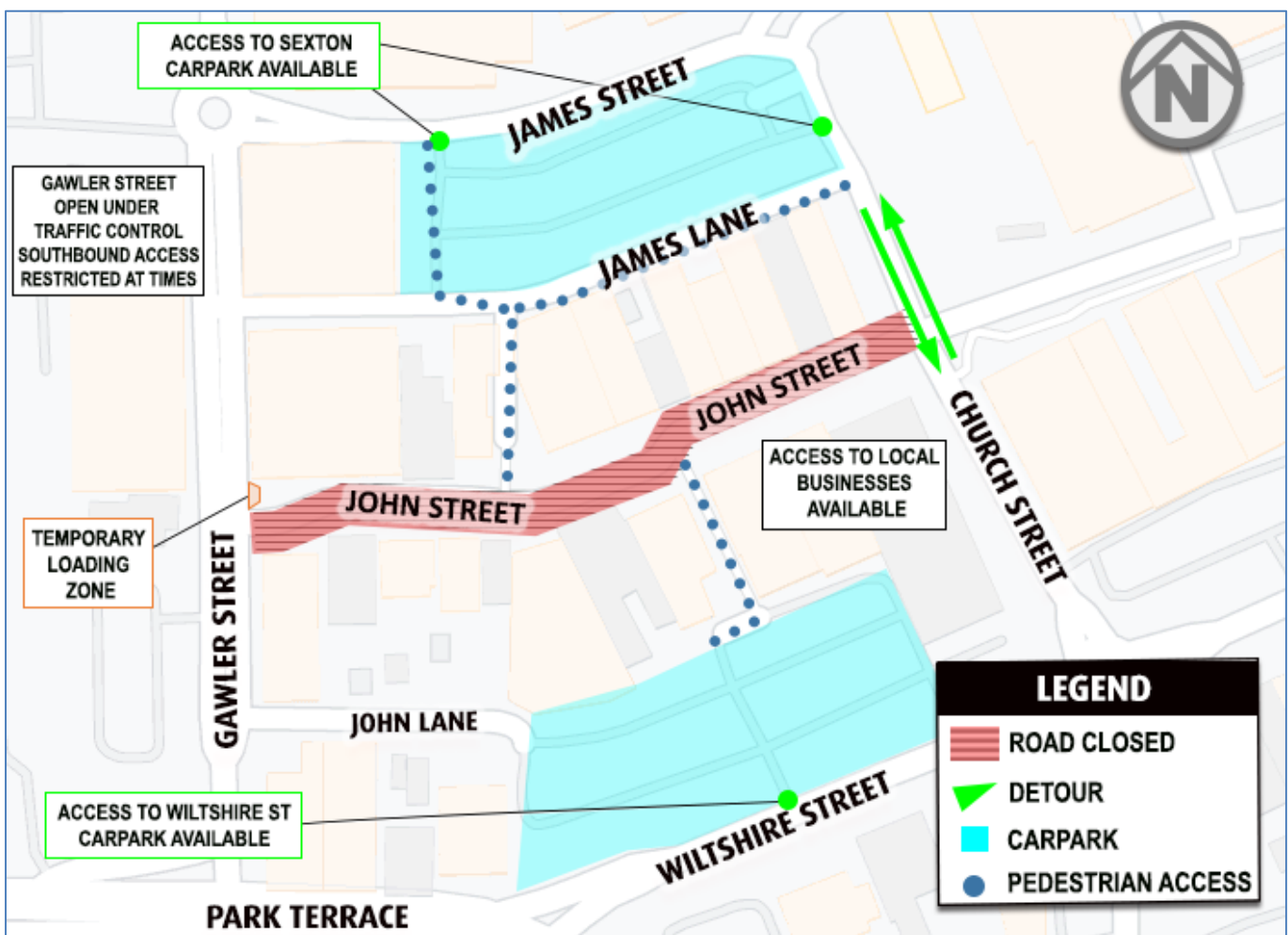
To facilitate the roll out of the Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project, the following road closure is required to undertake trenching and roadworks. This closure affects vehicle traffic only, with footpaths open at all times.

John Street (Gawler Street to Church Street)

Closed Monday 7 November at 6am until Wednesday 9 November at 5pm; and

Closed Monday 14 November at 6am until Wednesday 16 November at 5pm

Please note Gawler Street will be open under traffic control, with southbound access restricted at times.

What to expect

Temporary detours will be in place for each road closure. **Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.**

Construction will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby businesses, residents and road users as much as practically possible. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding businesses and road users

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restrictions to pedestrian and cyclist access with signage in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
