Church and John Streets Revitalisation Works notification




The \$8 million Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project is funded by the City of Salisbury with part funding from the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and will see the continued renewal of the City Centre, creating a sense of place which reflects Salisbury's heart and identity.

This project forms part of the City of Salisbury's City Plan 2035, aligning with the Salisbury City Centre Renewal Strategy.

Upcoming road closures

To facilitate demolition works for the Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project, the following road closure is required which restricts vehicle access only.

John Street - Closed Friday 30 September at 8pm until Saturday 1 October at 6am



What to expect

Temporary detours will be in place. Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Construction will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby businesses, residents and road users as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling works at night. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding businesses and road users

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restrictions to pedestrian and cyclist access with signage in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
