

Church and John Streets Revitalisation

Works notification

The \$8 million Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project, funded by the City of Salisbury, in partnership with the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program, will see the continued renewal of the City Centre, creating a sense of place which reflects Salisbury's heart and identity.

This project forms part of the City of Salisbury's City Plan 2035, aligning with the Salisbury City Centre Renewal Strategy.

Upcoming road closures

To facilitate the roll out of the Church and John Streets Revitalisation Project's Smart City infrastructure, the following road closures are required to accommodate road renewal works:

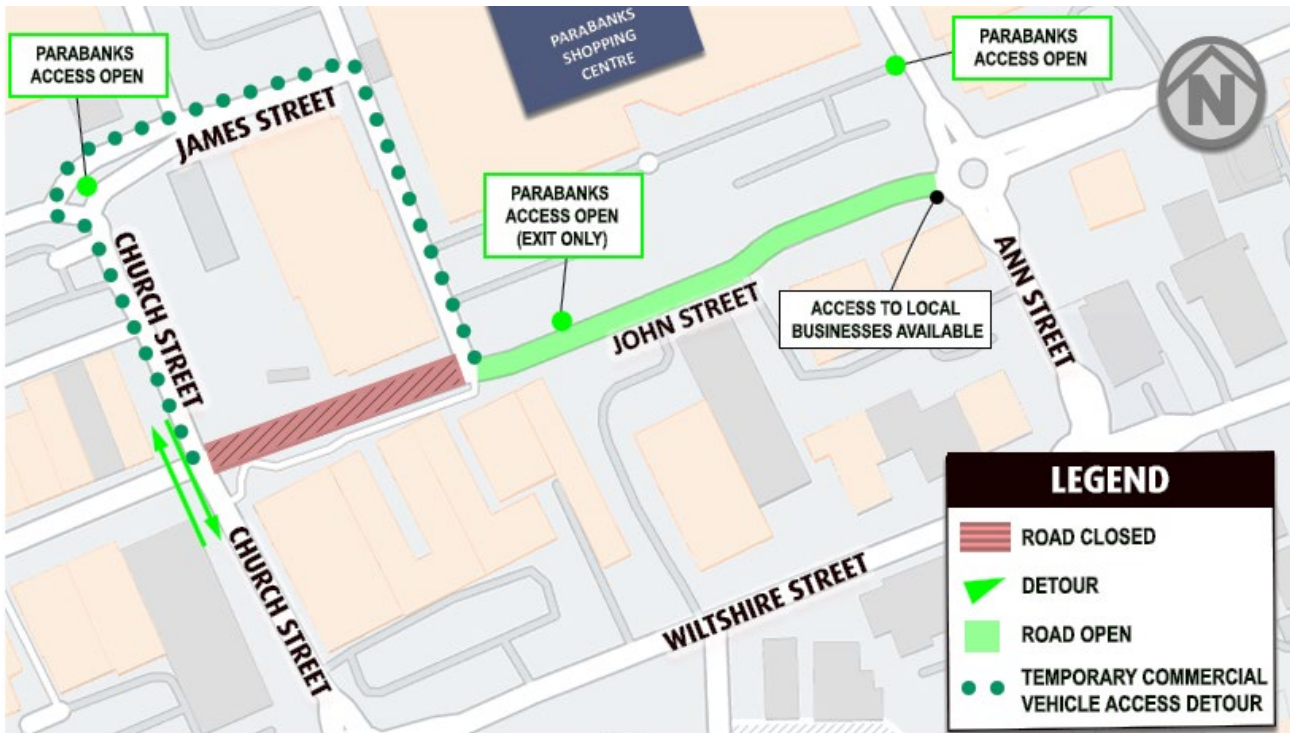
John Street (Gawler Street to Ann Street) - Closed Monday to Friday, 5.30am until 9.30am (Mornings only) until Wednesday 21 December 2022.

John Street (west) - Monday 9 January at 7am until Wednesday 18 January 2023 at 5pm (continuous)



All dates and times are subject to weather.

What to expect

Temporary detours will be in place for each road closure. Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restrictions to pedestrian and cyclist access with signage in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe all speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controller directions when travelling through the area.
