

The \$8 million Church and John Streets Revitalisation is funded by the City of Salisbury with part funding from the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and will see the continued renewal of the City Centre, creating a sense of place which reflects Salisbury's heart and identity. This project forms part of the City of Salisbury's City Plan 2035, aligning with the Salisbury City Centre Renewal Strategy.

Sexton Carpark works

As part of the revitalisation project, drainage and pavement works will be occurring in the Sexton Carpark between James Lane and James Street, from Thursday 16 June 2022 for approximately 8 weeks (weather permitting). During these works, some sections of the carpark will be closed with detours in place for vehicles and pedestrians.

Works in Zone 1 will start on 16 July 2022 and will take approximately two weeks.



Works in Zone 2 will immediately follow works in Zone 1 and will take approximately six weeks.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are undertaken, however works will be managed to minimise disruption to nearby residences and businesses as much as is practically possible.

Access to businesses will be maintained at all times, including from James Lane.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
