Option 1: Both sides of street



Chinese Tallow Tree
Triadica sebiferum

A deciduous tree, up to 8m in height, with a dense canopy. It has heart shaped foliage that turn red, orange and yellow in autumn and inconspicuous yellow-green flowers. This tree is recommended for small verges and under powerlines, and is SA Water approved.

Option 2: Both sides of street



Jacaranda
Jacaranda mimosifolia

A deciduous tree, up to 12m in height, with a spreading canopy. It has fern-like foliage and profuse purple flowers that appear in spring and summer. This tree is recommended for medium width verges and is SA Water approved.
Local example: Goodall Crescent, Salisbury; Davis Street, Salisbury

Option 3: Both sides of street



Sugar Hack Berry
Celtis laevigata

A deciduous tree, up to 12m in height, with a rounded, dense canopy of glossy, green leaves. Flowers are insignificant. This tree is suitable for a range of conditions and soils, and is drought tolerant. It is recommended for medium verges and is SA Water approved.
Local example: Maidos Grove, Valley View.
