

# Nicholls Crescent, Burton

## Option 1: Both sides of street



Callery Pear  
*Pyrus calleryana* 'Bradford'

A deciduous tree, up to 12m in height, with a dense canopy. Dark green foliage is thick and glossy, becoming red, orange and purple in autumn. White blossom flowers appear in spring. This tree is recommended for small and medium verges.

Local example: Redin Street, Richmond.

## Option 2: Both sides of street



Chinese Tallow Tree  
*Triadica sebiferum*

A deciduous tree, up to 8m in height, with a dense canopy. It has heart shaped foliage that turn red, orange and yellow in autumn and inconspicuous yellow-green flowers.

This tree is recommended for small verges and under powerlines, and is SA Water approved.

## Option 3: Both sides of street



Green Ash  
*Fraxinus pennsylvanica* 'Urbanite'

A deciduous tree, up to 10m in height, with a dense canopy. It has dull green coloured foliage that turns bronze in autumn. This tree is tolerant of a range of soil and climatic conditions and is recommended for medium verges.

Local example: Silverbirch Place, Mawson Lakes.
