The Index of Relative Socio-Economic Advantage and Disadvantage (IRSAD)

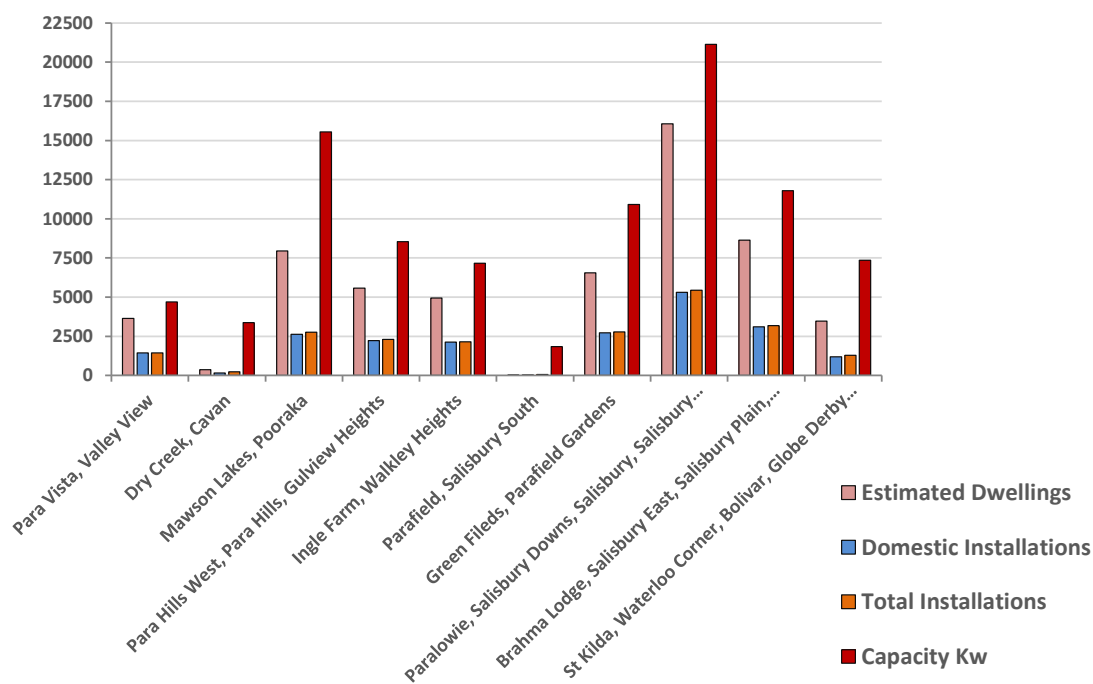

Why this indicator is important

The SEIFA (IRSAD) provides a general socio-economic index that summarises the economic and social attributes of people and households. A lower score could indicate many households with low income, educational attainment and low skill occupations. It is important to recognise that characteristics can be significantly different between areas.

Current Performance

The SEIFA (IRSAD) Index for the City of Salisbury was 908, ranked 17th in metropolitan Adelaide. Differentiated by areas (ABS Statistical Area 2), the index is between 807.8 and 1,045.5.
