

## Educational Attainment

**Headline Figure:** 50.9 % of Salisbury's working population have a post school qualification have a qualification level higher than Certificate 3.

### Why this indicator is important

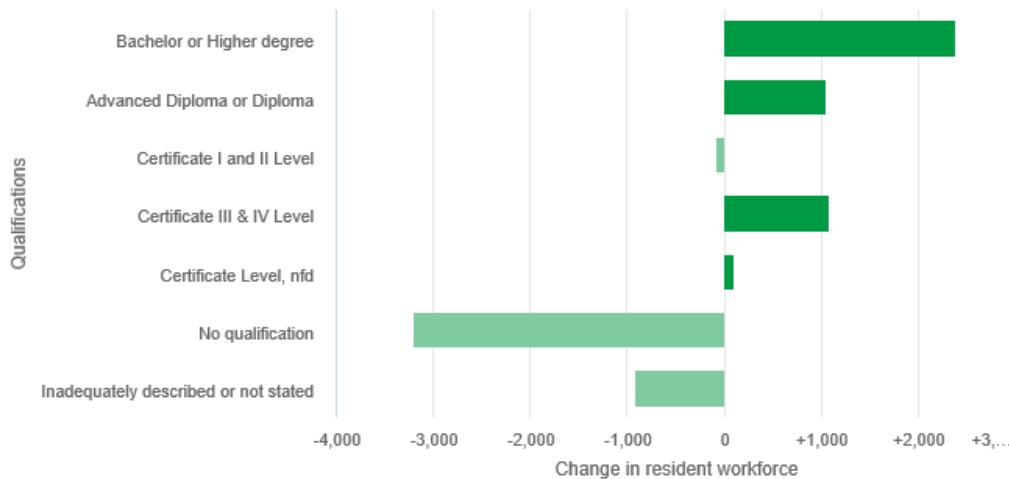
Educational attainment can be an important indicator as it influences opportunities for people to participate in the workforce, is a determinant of income levels and has a correlation to security of employment. Increasing qualification rates of residents is increasingly important if residents are to access opportunities provided in a knowledge-intensive economy.

### Current Performance

In the City of Salisbury 29,164 persons or 50.9% of Salisbury's working population had a post school qualification have a qualification level higher than Certificate 3. This is an increase of 4,534 people over 211.

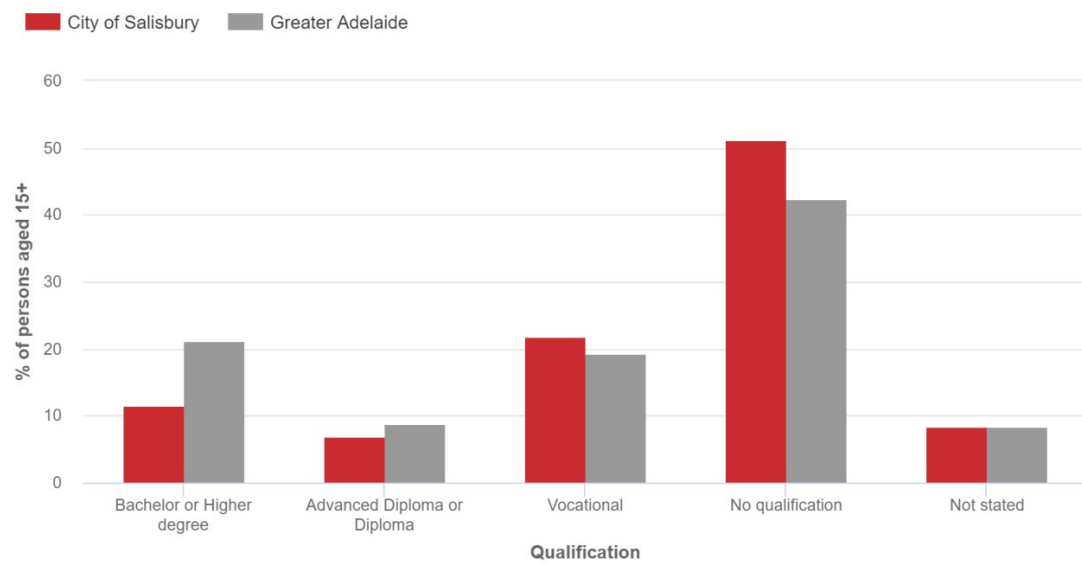
#### Change in resident workers qualifications, 2011 to 2016

More broadly, 40.4% of our residents aged 15+ have a vocational or university qualification. This compares to 49.3% for the same age grouping across the Greater Adelaide region.
