#### **Number of Jobs in Local Businesses**



### Why this indicator is important

This indicator measures the number of jobs that are provided by businesses and other organisations within the City of Salisbury. A count of jobs is one of the most fundamental economic indicators of the size of the local economy, and increasing numbers of jobs generally represent a growing economy. The creation of these jobs provides local opportunities for our residents to participate in paid employment or to progress their careers.

### **Current Performance**

The number of jobs in Salisbury's economy has grown on average by 1.7% over the past two decades. The City of Salisbury houses the third largest concentration of jobs in South Australia. The rate of job growth in Salisbury has exceeded the State average for three of the past five years, however the last two years have seen a slight slowing in jobs due largely to the loss of jobs in the construction sector
