CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Art work is submitted at entrant's own risk
- Entrants are permitted to submit 3 original artworks, any works that infringe copyright may be disqualified
- Entrants must be aged 12 to 25 years (at the time of closing date)
- The City of Salisbury reserves the right not to accept any entry it deems unsuitable or offensive
- Artwork must be wall based and not exceed 1.2m x 1.5m (including frame)
- Artwork may be submitted in any medium
- Entrants will need to upload a digital copy of their artwork to be included in the online voting gallery for the People's Choice Award
- All artworks should be presented ready for hanging. Flat 'D' rings must be placed on the back of the artwork (whether framed or not) 10cm down from the top edge of the work
- Entrant's name, phone number and title of work must be clearly printed on the back of the artwork
- Note: artworks are not to be offered for sale within the time of submission until the completion of the exhibition. The City of Salisbury will not engage as an agent for the purpose of selling the works on the entrants' behalf.
- Entries close: Friday June 25 2021.
- Entries need to be delivered for hanging to Twelve25 Youth Centre, 17 Wiltshire St, Salisbury between Tuesday 29th June- Thursday 1st July, 10am - 4pm

- Entries will be judged by a judging panel established by the City of Salisbury, the judging panel decisions will be final
- Winners will be announced on Wednesday 7th July, 6-7:30pm
- The artworks and their photographic reproductions may be used to develop promotional materials for future Youth activities. Artists accept that their work may be reproduced, in whole or in part, for promotional purposes by the City of Salisbury. Artists will be acknowledged by name and prize wherever the work is reproduced
- Images of the artwork will be displayed on the Youth in Salisbury Facebook page to promote the exhibition

All artworks are to be collected from Twelve25 Youth Centre, 17 Wiltshire St, Salisbury on Tuesday 13th July (between 9.30am and 4.30pm) or by arrangement by contacting 8406 8555.
