Mausoleum Indoor Flower Policy

This Policy has been created to provide a clear understanding of how families can use flowers to honour their loved ones in The Mausoleum located at the Salisbury Memorial Park.

For “Special Days”, families must phone or email to book a flower stand/bracket a minimum of two days before required.

- Calls to be made Monday to Friday between 9am to 5pm on (08) 8406 8222
- Email requests can be sent to cemetery@salisbury.sa.gov.au
- Special days are Birthdays, Anniversaries and Mother’s/Father’s Day only
- Stands will not be provided at Easter, All Souls day, Christmas or any other time

One Flower Pot Holder or Pedestal per crypt will be supplied, and what is supplied will depend on the location of the crypt.

- Level 1 – 3 Bronze Flower Pot Holder/bracket
- Level 4 – 6 Pedestal

Only professionally prepared fresh flowers in a **cardboard container** with “**oasis floral foam**” may be placed in the Mausoleum. The Mausoleum does not permit the use of home-grown flowers, or live plants.

The following items will be **removed immediately** without notice;

- Flowers or flower containers left on the ground
- Metal, glass, plastic or ceramic vases (Due to Occupational Health & Safety Regulations)
- Cards, souvenirs, etc. taped to the crypt wall or attached to lamps or vases.
- Flower containers full of water
- Flowers containing Tiger Lilies
- Home-grown flower arrangements, native everlasting plants or Live plants
- Expired flower arrangements
