Mausoleum Outdoor Flower Policy

This Policy has been created to provide a clear understanding of how families can use flowers to honour their loved ones in The Mausoleum located at the Salisbury Memorial Park.

For up to the first 3 months after an entombment, families are permitted to place multiple fresh flower arrangements near the crypt of their loved one.

After 3 months, and only on "Special Days", families can place flower arrangements near a crypt.

• Special days are Birthdays, Anniversaries and Mother's/Father's Day

Only professionally prepared fresh flowers in a **cardboard container** with **"oasis floral foam"** may be placed in and around the external of the building of the Mausoleum. The Mausoleum does not permit the use of home-grown flowers, or live plants.

The following items will be **removed immediately** without notice;

- Flowers or flower containers left on the ground
- Metal, glass, plastic or ceramic vases (Due to Occupational Health & Safety Regulations)
- Cards, souvenirs, etc. taped to the crypt wall or attached to lamps or vases.
- Flower containers full of water
- Flowers containing Tiger Lilies
- Home-grown flower arrangements, native everlasting plants or Live plants
- Expired flower arrangements

Items left on the mausoleum grounds including on the flower vases or the vigil lamps, become the property of the Salisbury Memorial Park and will not be held in storage.
