#### 3.1.2 Elected Member Online Attendance at Meetings

- 1. Approves the amendment of the Code of Practice section on "Remote Participation in Committee and Council Meetings" to include the Elected Member requirement to use a microphone and headset or combination of the two together when participating in online meetings.
- 2. Approves the provision of a suitable microphone and headset for each council member being one set per member for the term of Council unless damaged. Amend the elected member support policy to include this accordingly.
- 3. When attending online you should be using a blurred background for open meetings, and no background for confidential meetings and you should only be attending on council supplied technology

Notes that such powers and functions may be further delegated by the Chief Executive Officer as the Chief Executive Officer sees fit and in accordance with the relevant legislation unless otherwise indicated herein or in the Schedule of Conditions contained in the proposed Instrument of Delegation under the *Food Act 2001*.
