Recommendation

1. To enable the Committee to consider Item SLSCC2 in confidence on the basis the Council considers it necessary and appropriate to act in a meeting closed to the public (except those persons listed above) in order to receive, discuss or consider in confidence the following information or matter relating to Item CLSCC2 Walkleys Road Corridor – Business Case.

Information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the Council is:

- Conducting or proposing to conduct business
- Would prejudice the commercial position of the Council

And which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest, The information to be considered in relation to this Agenda item includes detailed costings and financial information, the disclose of which would prejudice the Council's commercial position during the current and ongoing negotiations.

- 2. The disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest because the public interest in the Council preserving its negotiating position with the person who Council is proposing to conduct business and obtaining best value for money for its community would be compromised by disclosure of the information.
- 3. Accordingly, on this basis, the principle that meetings of the Council should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed by the need to keep the information or matter confidential.
