 - information the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.
- 2. In weighing up the factors related to disclosure,
 - disclosure of this matter to the public would demonstrate accountability and transparency of the Council's operations
 - Non-disclosure of this report at this time will protect Council's commercial position as public disclosure may provide third parties with a commercial advantage.

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
IBD-C1 Salisbury Oval Development Site Update

- 1. Pursuant to Section 90(2) and (3)(b)(i) and (b)(ii) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Committee orders that the public be excluded from attendance at the part of this meeting relating to Agenda Item IBD-C1 Salisbury Oval Development Site Update, except staff of the City of Salisbury on duty in attendance. To enable the Committee to consider Item IBD-C1 Salisbury Oval Development Site Update in confidence on the basis that the Committee considers it necessary and appropriate to act in a meeting closed to the public (excepting those persons listed above) in order to receive, discuss or consider in confidence the following information or matter relating to Item IBD-C1 Salisbury Oval Development Site Update:
 - it relates to information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting, or proposing to conduct, business, or to prejudice the commercial position of the council; and
 - information the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.
- 2. The disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest because the public interest in the Council preserving its negotiating position with the successful tender and obtaining best value for money for its community would be compromised by disclosure of the information.
- 3. Accordingly, on this basis, the principle that meetings of the Council should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed by the need to keep the information or matter confidential.
