 - information the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest; and
 - commercial information of a confidential nature (not being a trade secret) the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or to confer a commercial advantage on a third party; and
 - commercial information of a confidential nature (not being a trade secret) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.
- 2. In weighing up the factors related to disclosure,
 - disclosure of this matter to the public would demonstrate accountability and transparency of the Council's operations
 - Non-disclosure of the matter and discussion of this item in confidence would protect confidential information relating to proposed commercial negotiations and Council's commercial position.

On that basis the public's interest is best served by not disclosing the **Landfill Alternate Project** item and discussion at this point in time. 3. Pursuant to Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999 it is recommended the Council orders that all members of the public, except staff of the City of Salisbury on duty in attendance, Chief Executive Officer,/General Manager City Development, General Manager Business Excellence, A/General Manager City Infrastructure, General Manager Community Development, Manager Governance, PA to GM Community Development, Manager Sport, Recreation & Community Planning, Manager Strategic Development Projects be excluded from attendance at the meeting for this Agenda Item.
