Pursuant to section 90(2) of the *Local Government Act 1999* the Finance and Corporate Services Committee Orders, this matter to be considered in confidence on grounds that:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 90(2) and (3)(b)(i) and (b)(ii) of the Local Government Act 1999, the principle that the meeting should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed in relation to this matter because:
 - it relates to information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting, or proposing to conduct, business, or to prejudice the commercial position of the council; and
 - information the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.
- 2. In weighing up the factors related to disclosure,
 - disclosure of this matter to the public would demonstrate accountability and transparency of the Council's operations
 - On that basis the public's interest is best served by not disclosing the **Confidential Bids First Quarter Budget Review 2023/24** item and discussion at this point in time.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999 it is recommended the Council orders that all members of the public, except staff of the City of Salisbury on duty in attendance (Chief Executive Officer, Deputy Chief Executive Officer, General Manager City Infrastructure, General Manager Community Development, General Manager City Development, Manager Governance, Team Leader Council Governance, Governance Support Officer, Assessment Manager, Manager Strategic Development Projects, Team Leader Community Compliance, Manager Field Services, Manager Infrastructure Delivery, Manager Urban, Recreation and Natural Assets, Team Leader Civil Maintenance), be excluded from attendance at the meeting for this Agenda Item.
